SUMMARY: The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Marine Monuments of the Pacific Office, located in Honolulu, Hawaii is looking for two Records Management Facilitators to assist in organizing our holdings. Our offices have extensive historical files spanning decades, which document the management, political history, and scientific research surrounding 22 national wildlife refuges and 4 marine national monuments throughout the Pacific. The collections consist of analog and digital records, maps, photographs, and other mixed media. Two interns will be stationed at the Honolulu office. We are looking for conscientious, resourceful, and motivated information professionals to become our in-house experts. The records management facilitators will be responsible for following a records schedule, organizing and digitizing files, keeping a records inventory, and disposing of files accordingly. You will gain hands-on experience with electronic records, preservation, digitization, metadata, records management, and content management systems. You will also gain experience prioritizing tasks, collaborating with others, establishing guidelines, and training other staff in records management tasks. Many responsibilities of the rotation will be distributed between the interns. The Honolulu interns will prioritize the big-picture potential of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service records room. For example, they will continue the goal of creating a sustainable filing system. They will also work together to digitize and purge records, as well as maintain the online catalog of U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service references. Other tasks include digitizing maps, downloading content from CDs and DVDs, and generally working to decrease the volume of mixed media accumulated in the records room. This internship is open to Wayne State University graduate students wishing to gain practical experience in archival practices and management. To be considered, applicants must be currently enrolled in a relevant track (i.e., history, public history, library science, archival management, anthropology), and have their advisor's approval for the appropriate class credit. The project involves processing material donated to the collection last year. This includes letters, photographs and ephemera. The student will learn how to enter this material into a Past Perfect

database, digitize and interpret this material, and store the physical and digital artifacts properly. While this is an archival internship, the appropriate candidate should also have interest in the workings of a public history organization. The program will involve research, writing, cataloging, and interpretation. Final deliverables regarding hours, reports, and grading will align with the internship program requirements of the applicant's major. Internship supervisor will be Joel Stone, DHS Senior Curator, with direction provided by a variety of archival and curatorial staff. The bulk of activity will take place at the Collections Resource Center (CRC) located at Historic Fort Wayne. Because of road closures due to bridge construction in the area, public transportation has been disrupted. Alternate transportation is suggested. This internship is named in honor of Dr. Philip Mason, an accomplished professor at WSU, and founder of the Walter P. Reuther Library of Labor and Urban Affairs. This position pays the student \$15 per hour up to 130 hours, with funding provided by the Prismatic Foundation and the Detroit Historical Society.
